

EBBS Sponsored International Lecturers

In 2009 EBBS started a new initiative replacing the former financial "workshop – support".

Members are invited to submit proposals to the committee for support for an EBBS sponsored International Lecturer at a local or national meeting or workshop. A travel grant of Euro 700,- will be awarded to defray the additional costs of a lecturer from another country. Applicants (who should be members of EBBS) should provide sufficient details to satisfy the committee that

- the lecturer would make an important contribution and enhance the meeting
- the lecture will raise the profile of both the meeting and the EBBS
- the meeting will be advertised widely, with EBBS support acknowledged
- the meeting will be open to all EBBS members
- a short report should be submitted after the meeting, to help us assess the efficacy of this scheme in supporting the aims of EBBS

Awards will be made on a case by case basis and will be competitive with other applications.

Applications (which should include a one-page c.v. of the nominated lecturer) should be made by June 1 / December 1 and addressed to the Secretary Verity Brown (vjb @ st-and.ac.uk).

Successful applicants will be informed after the meeting of the EBBS Committee in January /July (FENS years) or September (EBBS AGM)
