

I wish to apply for a position as an ordinary member of the EEBS committee. I am a Full Professor of Neuroscience in Besançon (France), where I teach integrative physiology, neuroscience, and behaviour. After training in Pharmacy and completing a PhD in Neuroscience in Strasbourg, I pursued postdoctoral research in Austria and France with Professors Werner Sieghart, Gunther Sperk, and Brigitte Kieffer.

My research focuses on brain mechanisms underlying adaptive behaviour and their dysregulation in neuropsychiatric disorders, including schizophrenia, anxiety, depression, and addictive and eating disorders. I study decision-making and the emotional, cognitive, and behavioural effects of chronic stress, using a dimensional approach that integrates sex as a biological variable. My work combines animal models and translational human studies, with current projects on the insular cortex, interoception, decision-making under uncertainty, and non-invasive brain stimulation (tDCS, VNS).

I am actively involved in training and dissemination, supervising Master's and PhD students and contributing regularly to international conferences. A member of several scientific societies, including EBBS since 2021, I am committed to advancing behavioural neuroscience. I would be pleased to contribute to the EEBS committee by supporting collaborative, rigorous, and inclusive scientific exchange.
