We very much expect the meeting to go ahead in person – but we will allow on-line registrations to be 'upgraded' to full attendance at a later date. If the event had to move online only we would refund any cost difference to those who have registered for full attendance.

NOW OPEN: Call for Travel Grant applications for the 2021 meeting

EBBS is offering 10 travel awards (3 for post-docs and 7 for PhD students) to attend our meeting in person in Lausanne in September.

Award winners will receive a €500 bank transfer after the meeting as well as a special EBBS Travel Award Certificate. Should the meeting move entirely online then the award will instead cover the cost of registration fees at the cost incurred to the applicant.

All applicants should be EBBS members at the time of application. Applications should include:

- A copy of the poster abstract identical to the one which will be submitted to the meeting. The applicant must be the first author on the abstract.
- A one page CV.

Applications should be sent to the Secretary General of the EBBS (Alex Easton, secretary@ebbs-science.org) by the end of Sunday 28th February 2021

Abstracts must be submitted in English and cannot be more than 250 words. Abstract topic: Submissions are welcome in all topics related to Behavioral Neuroscience Abstract title: The title should not exceed 25 words Body text: limited to 300 words Abstracts should clearly state: Aims, Methods, Results and Conclusions. Use only standard abbreviations. Place special or unusual abbreviations in parentheses after the full

word the first time it appears. We recommend using word-processing software (for example Word) for editing your abstract and counting the number of words.

NOW OPEN: Call for EBBS sponsored international lecturers

Members are invited to submit proposals for support of an EBBS sponsored International Lecturer at meetings, workshops or summer/winter schools. Applications for small, local meetings are discouraged. **Deadline February 28th 2021**

A travel grant of €700 will be awarded to defray the additional costs of a lecturer from another country. Applicants (who have to be members of EBBS) should provide sufficient details to satisfy the following points:

- the lecturer will make an important contribution and enhance the quality of the meeting
- the lecturer will raise the profile of both the meeting and the EBBS
- the meeting will be advertised widely, with EBBS support clearly acknowledged
- the meeting will be open to all EBBS members

Please note that a brief report on the meeting and lecture should be submitted after the meeting. Applications should include a one-page C.V. of the nominated lecturer. They should be made at least 6 months before the meeting and addressed to the Secretary (Alex Easton; secretary@ebbs-science.org).
